What are emergency communications?

Emergency communications are defined primarily as a means of communication through interpersonal communications services between an end-user and the PSAP with the goal to request and receive emergency relief from emergency services.

What is euccs project?

EUCCS Project has been recognised by the European Commission in the new EU Security Strategy. EUCCS is the acronym used for the European Critical Communication System, which aims to facilitate the equivalent of cross border broadband roaming for European emergency services.

What is the euccs initiative?

The EUCCS initiative was conceived following the Council Conclusions on the Protection of Public Spaces on June 7, 2021. These conclusions called for a robust, EU-wide communication system to ensure the security and interoperability of public safety communications.

What is euccs preparation?
