Tariffs and duties for importing solar panels from China (2024) Section 301 Tariffs: 15% on most Chinese solar panels (HS Code 8541.40.60). Bifacial Solar Panels: Exempt (0% duty as of 2024). Section 201 Safeguard Tariff: Expired in Feb 2022 (no longer applies). Merchandise Processing Fee (MPF): 0.3464% of shipment value (min \$27.23, max \$538.40).
