Are there electrical outlets in Denmark?

No, the electrical outlets in Denmark are different from those in the United States. In Denmark electrical outlets of types C, F, E & K are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Denmark? The electrical outlets and power plugs in Denmark are of types C, F, E & K (see images).

What type of outlet do you use in Denmark?

Denmark's charming streets and hygge lifestyle are complemented by type C, E, F and K outlets, not the type we use in the US. Remember to bring a travel adapter on your Scandinavian escape. Type C outlets also work with type C and F plugs. Type C plugs also fit into type E outlets. Type F outlets also work with type C and E plugs.

What type of plugs does Denmark use?

Denmark uses power outlets and plugs of types C, F, E & K. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Doesn't look familiar? Do the outlets look different in your country? You'll need a power plug adapter. Type C - The standard European plug.

Do I need a travel adapter in Denmark?

Check what kind of travel adapter you'll need. In Denmark, they use Type C, E, F, and K power plugs and outlets. Type C outlets have two round prongs and no grounding pin. Type E and F plugs usually fit too, but grounded plugs will need an adapter. Type E outlets have two round prongs and a grounding pin at the top.
