How many telecom sites are there in Malaysia?

Operators in Malaysia still own over 16,000 sites in Malaysia. Many of these sites are managed by the operators themselves, but Malaysia is also one of EDOTCO's largest managed sites markets, and the towerco collects a fee to manage 13,268 telecom towers in the market.

How many base stations were upgraded to 4G in 2021?

Maxis, Celcom, Digi and U Mobile upgraded 13,807 Base Stations to 4G technology in 2021 (total 30,174 base stations upgraded from September 2020 to December 2021). YTL Communications and unifi Mobile were not mentioned. Constructed a total of 313 new 4G towers in 2021.

Does Malaysia have a 5G network?

In October 2024 the Malaysian government announced the award of its second open access 5G network to the country's smallest MNO, U Mobile. Digital Nasional Berhad (DNB) will continue to operate the first open access network as it has since May 2023.
